Description of departments:

Front of house: Includes reception, the financial side of the hotel, organising and running weddings and events, working the bar, running the restaurant, keeping the hotel to its regular high standards of cleanliness.

Kitchen: The student will learn, experience and become an integral part of the thriving Merewood Kitchen. This includes learning how to prepare food for evening service and for weddings and functions, as well as learning and taking part in how service works. The student will also become familiar with typical clean down procedures and the immense importance of health and hygiene in our kitchen.

Housekeeping: This department will show the student the little known side of hotels and give them the insight as to how the housekeeping department plays an important role in an efficient hotel. The student will learn how to prepare rooms for the arrival of guests, as well as general servicing of the rooms. The housekeeping department mirrors the front of house department with regards to standards of cleanliness, which the student will experience.
