Accessibility Report

Briery wood can be reached by leaving the M6 at junction 36 and following the A591 for 15 miles, past Kendal and Windermere, until you see Briery Wood signed on the right.

The nearest airport is Manchester.

The nearest train station is Windermere, approximately 3 miles from the hotel.

Buses run frequently past the hotel and taxis are available locally.

Briery Wood is within easy reach of the popular villages of Ambleside, Bowness and Windermere.

The hotel & its grounds are set into the hillside, with a gradual incline from the bottom to the top of the property. We have seven acres of gardens, ranging from lawns, to cultivated areas, to woodland. The footpaths are mainly gravel. Some areas have steps. Seating is available on our patio during the Summer. There are benches, chairs and a gazebo in the grounds.

We have a gravel car park, with an overspill car park below it. The top car park and drive are on the same level, with a short ramp (with handrail) up to the reception door, which open outwards. The area is well lit and carpeted. There are chairs and a table as well as the reception area itself.

When entering the building you will first come to reception. If the area is unmanned, there is a bell to call a member of staff. If you require assistance with your luggage, a member of staff will be only too happy to help. You will be shown to your room, being advised of the communal areas as you go.

All corridors are well lit and carpeted. There is level access between corridors and communal areas. Low energy lighting is now used in most of the hotel's communal areas.

The carpeted lounges contain an array of different types of seating, from sofas, to lounge chairs, to stools. There are several low tables in these areas. Food and drink can be served to you in all of the lounges. Free Wi-Fi is available in all communal areas. Please ask for the password upon arrival.

There are WCs in the public areas with level access.

The restaurant and bar are situated adjacent to the lounges and public areas. Both areas are carpeted and well lit, with level access. Seating in the bar is a mixture of sofas and stools, with several low tables. Seating in the restaurant is at our dinner tables. We operate a mainly table service, with the exception of our buffet at breakfast and the bar. We can cater for most dietary requirements here as we produce all meals on site.

We have 23 en-suite bedrooms. 12 of our rooms are on the ground floor, but please note that there are several steps up to all of them. Some furniture can be moved upon request. Most of our rooms can be either kings or twin-bedded, depending on guests' requirements. Extra beds can be put up in some rooms to accommodate children. All rooms are carpeted, with storage in the form of a wardrobe and chest of drawers. All of the bedding we use in the hotel is hypoallergenic.

Each en-suite bathroom contains basin, WC and either a bath with overhead shower or shower cubicle. There is level access between bedroom and bathroom.

Our evacuation and fire procedures are shown on the back of each bedroom door. All staff are trained in the event of a fire. There is a folder of information in each room, with further information available at reception upon request.

We welcome assistance dogs here at the Briery Wood, along with pet dogs at prior arrangement.
